# Highway Safety Specialist (HSS) Position Description

- Assignment to this position is based on need and requires compliance with the job qualifications
- Full-time entry-level position



# HSS Duties

- Coordinate the traffic safety planning of the tribal programs to increase traffic safety measures carried out on the reservation



# HSS Duties:

- Responsible for establishing and conducting Traffic related activities such as identifying, collecting, analyzing, and presenting traffic safety data



# HSS Position Description

- Incorporating data into tribal statistic planning, programming, and implementation
- Organizing groups, events, and activities to increase community awareness of traffic safety related issues





# HSS Activities

- Create Traffic Safety Messages
- Become CPS Certified
  - Set Up Car Seat Clinics
    - Provide Car Seat Training
    - Distribute Car Seats
- Conduct Road Assessments
- Monitor Speed to determine problem Areas
- Compile and Reconcile Monthly Requests for Reimbursement



# Traffic Safety Planning

- Develop methods and protocols for collecting and analyzing the data for traffic safety planning purposes
- Coordinate with technical assistance resources for help in analyzing the data for traffic safety planning processes

- Award is based on the Tribes demonstrated need
- Applications due **May 1** (each year)
